An update on the plans for the Tudor Fayre and a few pleas for help as well !

The committee have been meeting regularly to get things organised for our first Fayre in a few years. We have the Hungerford Household living history society, who are coming to do some workshops and to be introducing us to how the Tudors (rich and poor) would have lived. We have a hog roast, ice cream, and our usual teas to keep us fed and watered. The Teachers and pupils are planning some exciting activities and goods for us to sell. And we have a few more things in the pipeline!!!

Competitions

We are encouraging as many people as possible to come along in **Tudor dress** and there will be an award for the best children's costume!

Heraldic Shield

Towards the end of term the children will be finding out about a competition to design a Tudor shield. The blank shield will be sold for 50p for them to decorate at home over the summer and returned during the first week of term. These will then be displayed during the Fayre and with awards given for each year group on the day!

Tudor Club

This is an opportunity for the children to come along and make Tudor themed items – some for fun and some to sell! The committee will run two sessions afterschool in the hall on **Thursday 1st July** and **Thursday 8th July from 3.15 – 5.30** and a small refreshment will be provided! Craft Night

We are having an evening session to make some items for the Tudor product stall for example – lavender ribbon favours, simple bracelets and necklaces, putting together kits for children, cutting

out heraldic shields etc. All these things are very simple and you won't need to be 'crafty'!! If you would like to join us on **Thursday 24th June** from 8pm please let one of our committee know.

Items we need

As the Fayre will be only two weeks after the start of term we are going to tell you now all the things we will be asking you for to help us make this a successful event

Home Produce (run by Louise Summerley and Mary Taylor-Lane)

Vegetables and fruit from your garden or allotment that you don't need, home made cakes (wrapped to sell please!), handmade cards, craft items, handmade jewellery, homemade jams and preserves, chutneys, bunches of flowers from the garden, eggs from your hens, in fact anything you can think of made or produced by you, your family or friends! Please bring any of this either at the end of school on Friday 17th September or ideally on the morning of Sunday 19th September.

Plant Stall (run by Lesley Mckie and Erica Scott)

Cuttings and plants potted up ready to sell.

Teas (run by Carmen Woods and Jude Aspinall)

We will need lots of cakes, handed over in the usual way!!!

Tombola (run by Lyndsey Ramsay)

Bottles of all shapes, sizes and contents for the adult bottle tombola. New unwanted gifts and non-alcoholic bottles for the children's tombola. (no second hand toys please)

Tudor Stall

Bunches of dried lavender. Sweetmeats – we can provide you with a recipe!

Other items

To make the event look good we would like to borrow any bunting you may have and if you have a gazebo you would be willing to lend us we would be very grateful.

Volunteers

School may ask some children to help run the school stall (Tudor products)

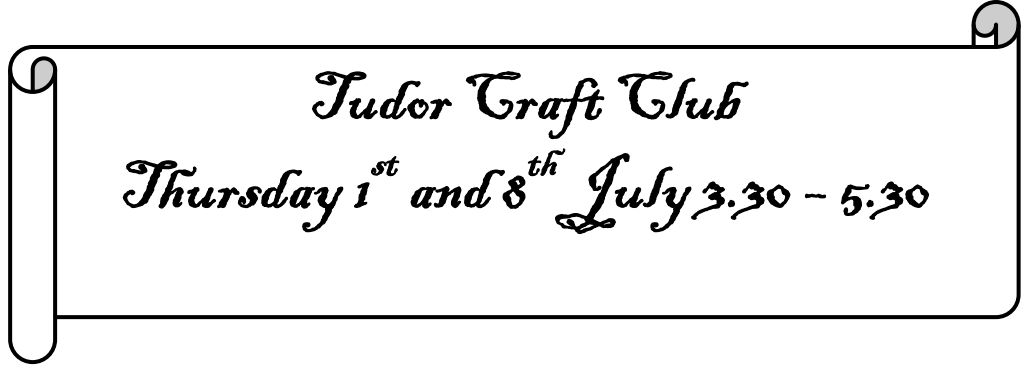
First aid trained people prepared to be a point of contact.
